Trail Update...appreciate where you ride!!

Many of you may have been reading the articles in the local Three Lakes paper regarding Trail #13 which runs between Three Lakes and Eagle River. Three Lakes Trails received official notification that the developer in Clearwater Lake has closed the trail. This trail was one of the first trails developed back in the late 1960's and became a main corridor trail as the state trail system was developed. An attempt to reroute Trail #13 using the north Sugar Camp trail to Hwy.

17 is underway. As you pull your newly polished sleds out of the garage or off the trailer this year, please think twice when blasting across someone's unmarked field or making your own short cut through the trees to a favorite destination. It takes many hours of work to secure landowner agreements and more hours to keep them open for everyone's enjoyment. Please respect the property so graciously given to us as well as it's owners.
