Treasurer's Report: Joyce Nykolayko reported that our current bank balance is \$5395. \$1260 has been collected for Ride with Pride. There are 18 new members and 238 renewals to date. Treasurer's report was approved. There was no written report submitted.

Trails Report – Ed G had no report on trails.

Amended By-Laws – Eric asked if there were any comments or discussion re the revisions of the by-laws. There were none. Eric asked for a motion to accept the amended by-laws, which was seconded and motion unanimously passed.

Overnight Ride – Mark O reported that 21 rooms have been booked and another 5 have been blocked.
